## Afghanistan

### Radio Afghanistan

Radio Afghanistan is the Taliban-operated national radio broadcasting station of Afghanistan. The shortwave transmitter at Pol-e-Charkhi in Kabul (100 kW on 6100 kHz) has been inactive since early 2020.

### Target broadcasts to Afghanistan

Following the overthrow of the Taliban in the 2001 US invasion of Afghanistan, there was an increase in the number of target broadcasts to the country to counter the extremist propaganda that had been spread in the preceding years. The Taliban returned to power in 2021 after capturing Kabul and overthrowing the government of the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan, ending the 2001–2021 war, and in September 2021 the Taliban re-established the Islamic Emirate of Afghanistan. The Taliban government remains internationally unrecognised and whilst this is the case, target broadcasts continue to provide both news, information and entertainment to Afghans. Christian broadcasters also continue to target the country. These are the stations broadcasting to Afghanistan for A24:

### Radio Afghanistan International

On 15 August 2021, the day the Taliban captured Afghanistan's capital Kabul, Volant Media UK Ltd, the parent company of Iran International TV, launched Afghanistan International TV (AITV), also known on air as Radio Afghanistan International. It aspires to serve as an international news network to provide reliable information for audiences and protect media freedom in the country. As of April 2024, Radio Afghanistan International has not been heard on 7600 kHz from either of its presumed transmitter sites.

## **Bangladesh**

### **Bangladesh Betar - Home Service**

Bangladesh Betar is the state-owned radio broadcaster of Bangladesh. The Home Service has nationwide coverage on mediumwave and FM. The transmitter at Savar, Dhaka District, that had aired the domestic service on shortwave in previous years is now used by the external service between 1230-2000 (see below).

### **International broadcasting on shortwave**

### **Bangladesh Betar - External Service**

Bangladesh Betar's External Service had a new Thomson 250 kW shortwave transmitter and rotatable antenna system installed at Khabirpur in 2012. However, since March 2019 the external service has not been heard on any of its usual shortwave frequencies from Khabirpur and has been using the domestic service transmitter at Savar on 4750 kHz instead (with a non-directional aerial). As a result the external service is currently heard best in areas surrounding Bangladesh (i.e. South and South-East Asia) rather than other parts of the world it may announce in its broadcasts..

## **Bhutan**

### **Bhutan Broadcasting Service**

BBS is now inactive on shortwave. It had broadcast on 6035 kHz daily from 0555 to approximately 1900 local time (0000-1300v UTC), but was last reported by Ron Howard in November 2020. Despite checks since then it has not been heard and is presumed to have permanently left shortwave.

# China

## China Media Group

China Media Group, also known as Voice of China, is the predominant state media company for radio and television broadcasting in the People's Republic of China. It was founded on 21 March 2018 as a national holding firm for China Central Television, China National Radio, and China Radio International. China Media Group is under the control of the Publicity Department of the Chinese Communist Party.

## China National Radio

CNR is the state-operated radio service of the Peoples Republic of China. It forms the national radio service of the state-owned China Media Group, continuing its mission to broadcast a variety of radio programmes to listeners all over China around the world.

## CNR-1 - Voice of China, News Radio

Voice of China is the flagship radio station of CNR, broadcasting mainly news and commentaries.

### **Sound of Hope**

Sound of Hope (SOH) is an international Chinese-language radio network. Along with New Tang Dynasty Television and The Epoch Times, it is part of a network of media organisations established by practitioners of the Falun Gong new religious movement. SOH serves the Chinese diaspora in US, Europe, Australia, Japan and South Korea on mediumwave and FM and broadcasts to China on an extensive number of out-of-band shortwave frequencies. Programmes are in Chinese and Cantonese, and also include relays of Radio Free Asia at times.

**Transmitter sites:** Pingtung and Miaoli, Taiwan - all transmitters are low power - 1 kW or less.

**Frequencies:** The frequencies and times below are those listed for A24 in the Shortwave Frequency List compiled by Shiganori Aoki on the [Nagoya DXers Circle](#) website (list dated 31 March 2024)

**Jamming:** most frequencies will be jammed by co-channel CNR-1 from Mainland China, which in most cases will be the dominant signal when listening from afar. See Ron Howard's tips below on how to distinguish between SOH and CNR.

### **Identifying Sound of Hope (Taiwan) vs CNR-1 jamming**

Sound of Hope (SOH) is quite often jammed by a transmission of China National Radio's CNR-1 service from Mainland China. **Ron Howard** offered some tips on how to identify SOH in a post to the WOR iog on 17 May 2021.

For me, it has always been fun trying to tie down if a station heard is really a Sound of Hope reception or just the CNR-1 program jamming. Here are a few suggestions, based on my years of observations:

1) One positive way is to listen at the top-of-the-hour. **CNR-1 programming always has time pips, while SOH never has any.**

2) Find a known CNR-1 frequency, that is to say a non-jamming frequency (I use 6125 kHz.), then check to find if it is // to the station in question.

3) SOH is a religious station, so has a more refined format. At ToH usually has news and then a lot of monologues. Rather rare to hear music. While the CNR-1 format is fairly contemporary; many short segments; often with music; in general has a much more upbeat format than SOH.

4) After many years of listening to SOH, I find their audio slightly muffled; not a lot, just enough to be noticeable, especially when compared to the crisp audio of CNR-1.

5) It is not uncommon for SOH to be slightly off-frequency; while CNR-1 is on the exact frequency (xx.00).

6) Finally, if the station in question has fair to good reception, it almost certainly is CNR-1 jamming. SOH stations use rather low power, hence fair-good reception would be extremely rare.

7) If you are fortunate enough to actually hear SOH, their top-of-the-hour ID is "**Xiwang zhi sheng guoji guangbo diantai**" (Sound of Hope international broadcast station), given twice (once by OM and once by YL), then into the news. My audio of a typical ToH SOH ID format is posted at <http://bit.ly/3l6V2kn>.

## **India**

### **Akashvani**

Akashvani, formerly known as All India Radio, is the radio broadcaster of India and a division of Prasar Bharati (Broadcasting Corporation of India), an autonomous corporation of the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting. As of May 2023, the use of the name "Akashvani" is progressively replacing "All India Radio", as instructed by the Director General of the corporation.

### **Regional Stations on shortwave**

Regional stations broadcast in Hindi, English and the principal languages of the respective states and Union Territories. As well as programmes originating from regional studios, they also relay news broadcasts and Network programmes from Delhi. After further closures on 31 December 2021, the last remaining regional station on shortwave is Leh.

### Akashvani Leh (Ladakh region)

Ladakh is a region administered by India as a union territory, and constitutes a part of the larger Kashmir region, which has been the subject of dispute between India, Pakistan, and China since 1947. It was established on 31 October 2019, following the passage of the Jammu and Kashmir Reorganisation Act. Ladakh is bordered by the Tibet Autonomous Region to the east, the Indian state of Himachal Pradesh to the south, both the Indian-administered union territory of Jammu and Kashmir and the Pakistan-administered Gilgit-Baltistan to the west, and the southwest corner of Xinjiang across the Karakoram Pass in the far north. It extends from the Siachen Glacier in the Karakoram range to the north to the main Great Himalayas to the south. The eastern end, consisting of the uninhabited Aksai Chin plains, is claimed by the Indian Government as part of Ladakh, and has been under Chinese control since 1962.

### **Why Yamata transmitters can not broadcast the program of "Furusato no Kaze"**

Ron Howard made a very useful comment on the WOR iog on 10 June 2021: "It might be worthwhile to be reminded of a past posting by Glenn, with info from online":

Currently 3 programs "Shiokaze", "Furusato no Kaze" and "Nippon no Kaze" are broadcast towards North Korea from VT Communications, and only "Shiokaze" is transmitted from Yamata. Why can't the Yamata transmitter send the message of "Furusato no Kaze" towards North Korea?

Japanese law on broadcasting says only NHK can broadcast "international service". And government controlled the license of broadcasting – it is quite difficult to get the permission (license) of broadcasting promptly.

At the opening announcement of Shiokaze, they announce call sign as JSR. Exactly speaking, JSR is not call sign for "general" radio stations. Shiokaze got a license for a "special utility broadcast" - the same as Traffic Information Service Radio on 1620 kHz - not for "general broadcast". [So Shiokaze is not really a "clandestine" station - Ron]

In the case of "Furusato no Kaze", they get neither the license of "utility broadcast" nor "general broadcast". And NHK reject the proposal of Japanese government to broadcast "Furusato no Kaze" within the program of Radio Japan. Thus Yamata transmitter can not send message of "Furusato no Kaze." [nor can they broadcast "Nippon no Kaze" - Ron]

# Korea (North)

## Radio and Television Broadcasting Committee of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea

The Radio and Television Broadcasting Committee of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea is the state-owned broadcaster of North Korea. The committee is under the Cabinet of North Korea, but its personnel is chosen and appointed by the Propaganda and Agitation Department (PAD) of the Workers' Party of Korea.

All three major television stations and 200 radio stations are controlled by the committee. The exceptions are Pyongyang FM Broadcasting Station, Pyongyang Broadcasting Station, and the Voice of National Salvation, which are under the United Front Department of the Workers' Party of Korea instead. The committee also controls the Korean Central News Agency.

## Korean Central Broadcasting Station

The Korean Central Broadcasting Station (KCBS) is the main domestic radio network in the DPRK. It sits under the Central Broadcasting Committee of the DPRK. KCBS broadcasts from 5am to 3am local time via a network of mediumwave and shortwave transmitters that cover the nation. The powerful transmissions can easily be heard in neighbouring countries, including South Korea where some of its frequencies are jammed. It is also relayed at certain times via the Voice of Korea, the DPRK's international shortwave service. A central programme is broadcast from Pyongyang on most transmitters through the entire broadcast day, but some are reported to carry regional programming between 2pm and 3pm. All programming is in Korean and includes music, talk and news. Main news bulletins are broadcast at 6am, 7am, 10am, midday, 3pm, 5pm, 8pm, 9pm and 10pm. (description as per Martyn Williams, northkoreatech.org, 3 November 2010, although still appears valid despite the age)

### **Target broadcasts to North Korea concerning Japanese abductees**

#### **JSR Shiokaze (Sea Breeze)**

Shiokaze (Sea Breeze) broadcasts to North Korea and is operated by the independent investigating organisation "Investigation Commission on Missing Japanese Probably Related to North Korea", regarding persons believed to have been abducted by North Korea prior to 1983. The daily shortwave radio programme broadcast from Tokyo highlights the plight of those who were kidnapped. It is compiled in an office owned by the group which campaigns to keep the issue in the public eye and supports the families of those abducted. JSR Shiokaze radio is broadcast twice a day for 30 minutes. There are editions in Japanese, Korean, English and Chinese, and they include the latest news about the abduction issue, messages to those abducted and appeals for help in finding them.

## Laos

### Lao National Radio

Lao National Radio is the national radio station of Laos. The transmitter of LNR on 6130 kHz (Vientiane 50 kW) has not been reported since 2020. It was scheduled at 2200-0800 and 0900-1630 and included foreign language programmes in Chinese (1400-1430), English (1430-1500), French (1500-1530), Thai (1530-1600) and Vietnamese (1600-1630).

## Malaysia

### Wai FM

Wai FM is a, Iban-language radio station in Sarawak operated by Radio Televisyen Malaysia. RTM caused outcry in August 2020 when it switched from the existing programme format that was popular with Iban-speaking listeners in the state and the decision was quickly reversed when Malaysian government ministers intervened.

Any Maldivian who follows Christ must remain secret or face arrest or expulsion from the country. The Maldivian government seeks to eliminate or greatly minimize outside influences on their cultural identity, which includes complete commitment to Islam". It went on to say that "VOM uses creative, secretive methods to share the gospel inside the Maldives". For the duration of the time that it was heard on shortwave, VOM broadcast at 1500-1530 on 11620 kHz. Whilst VOM said that "due to our agreement with our radio broadcast partner, we are unable to share the location of the transmission" it was thought that it hired airtime on a shortwave transmitter in Uzbekistan, although this was never confirmed. Programmes were in both Dhivehi and English. VOM announced that its final broadcast was on 31 March 2024. Myanma Radio's Minorities Service had since 10 January 2024 been noted at times on 5919 kHz, and other times on its usual frequency of 5915 kHz. It is usually scheduled 2330-1400 UTC. Initial observations were made by Rob Wagner and Ron Howard, and Rob has written a feature on [The Myanmar Broadcasting Scene](#) on his [Mount Evelyn DX Report](#) site with daily updates on MR's unusual frequency behaviour at the current time.

Myanma Radio Minorities Service was observed still on 5919 kHz from tune-in as early as 0900 to sign-off at 1400 UTC when checked between 20-23 January 2024, but was back on 5915 kHz on 7 February. (Tony Rogers using KiwiSDR's at Dimapur, Siliguri and Nepal); reports also indicate Myanma Radio was back on 5919 kHz in March 2024.

### **Thazin Radio**

Thazin Radio is operated by the Burmese military. It is based in Pyin Oo Lwin, a scenic hill town in the Mandalay Region, which has approximately 10,000 Indian and 8,000 Gurkha inhabitants who settled there during British rule. Today, Pyin Oo Lwin has a thriving Eurasian community, consisting mostly of Anglo-Burmese and Anglo-Indians. There is also a diverse mix of Chinese, Chin, Kachin, Karen, Shan, Bamars (Burmese) and communities.

At the time of editing the exact frequencies and times of operation of Thazin Radio are unconfirmed. There is information available that suggests what the schedules are for both the Main Programme and the Minorities Programme, but these need to be monitored carefully. The frequencies to check are:

Main Programme: 6030, 6165 and 9460 kHz at different times of the day between 2330-1500

Minorities Programme: 6165, 7345 and 9590 kHz at different times of the day between 2330-1430

### Target broadcasts in Rohingya

The Rohingya conflict is an ongoing conflict in the northern part of Myanmar's Rakhine State (formerly known as Arakan), characterised by sectarian violence between the Rohingya Muslim and Rakhine Buddhist communities, a military crackdown on Rohingya civilians by Myanmar's security forces, and militant attacks by Rohingya insurgents in Buthidaung, Maungdaw, and Rathedaung Townships, which border Bangladesh. An estimated 655,000 to 700,000 Rohingya people reportedly fled to Bangladesh between 25 August 2017 and December 2017, to avoid ethnic and religious persecution by Myanmar's security forces in their "clearance operations" against insurgents, joining an additional 300,000 Rohingya refugees in Bangladesh who had arrived after fleeing earlier waves of communal violence. The United Nations Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (OCHA) estimated on 31 July 2018 that 128,000 Rohingyas were internally displaced inside of Rakhine State.

### Voice of America

In July 2019, the Voice of America's Bangla language service started a five-day-a-week radio show in Rohingya, the language spoken by Muslim refugees that have fled Myanmar and it continues into 2024. More than 800,000 people have taken refuge at the Kutupalong camp, one of the world's largest refugee camps at the Myanmar-Bangladesh border. Titled Lifeline, the 30-minute radio show focuses on the lives and needs of the refugees, providing them with valuable information on security, family reunification, food rations, available shelter, education and health including vaccinations and water purification. In addition, a daily segment of the program offers the refugees the opportunity to share their stories, extend greetings to their families and learn about the hazards of joining extremists groups. One overarching objective of the broadcast is to counter Muslim extremists' narratives and recruitment efforts in the camps and inform the Rohingya about the U.S. and the international community's involvement in the crisis.

## Nepal

### Radio Nepal

Radio Nepal is the state-owned radio broadcasting service of Nepal. The shortwave transmitter that last operated on Radio Nepal's longstanding frequency of 5005 kHz has been decommissioned. It was last reported in early 2019.

## Pakistan

### Radio Pakistan

Radio Pakistan shortwave transmissions are currently suspended. The Ministry of Information and Broadcasting website currently says: "World and External services broadcasts programs for six hours daily in six foreign languages and designed to cover Asia. These languages are Persian, Dari, Bangla, Chinese, Pashto (Afghani), Hindi, Hazargi. Presently these programmes are streamed only and also available on the Mobile App. World Service broadcasts programs for 8 hours in Urdu language for Overseas Pakistanis in Middle East and Europe".

### Azad Kashmir Radio

The Pakistan Broadcasting Corporation broadcasts a dedicated Kashmir-focused service from three stations, including the Trarkhal Programme which had been heard as recently as October 2021 at 0900-0945 on 7265 kHz. However, there do not appear to have been any reports since then and the transmitter may be either inactive or only used irregularly.

## Russia (East Asia)

## Singapore

### Mediacorp (ex-Singapore Broadcasting Corporation)

Shortwave broadcasts of Mediacorp domestic services were discontinued on 31 July 2008. At the time of closure these consisted of Capital 95.8FM/YES 93.3FM in Chinese, 938Live! in English, Oli 96.8FM in various Indian languages and Warna 94.2FM/Ria 89.7FM in Malay. At the same time Radio Singapore International was also terminated on shortwave.

### BBC East Asia Relay Station

The BBC East Asia Relay Station was located in the Kranji district of Singapore. The relay station had been in use since 1978 and closed on 15 July 2023.



# Sri Lanka

### Sri Lanka Broadcasting Corporation

SLBC is the public broadcasting service of Sri Lanka. On SW it operates from the old Deutsche Welle Relay Station at Trincomalee, which was opened in 1984 and closed on 1 November 2011. Upon closure it was transferred to the SLBC.

### SLBC Shortwave Services

SLBC operates on shortwave from the old Deutsche Welle Relay Station at Trincomalee, which was opened in 1984 and closed on 1 November 2011. Upon closure it was transferred over to the Sri Lanka Broadcasting Corporation. SLBC broadcasts on shortwave are directed to South Asia and to the large expatriate community in the Middle East.

### Sound of Hope

Sound of Hope (SOH) is an international Chinese-language radio network. Along with New Tang Dynasty Television and The Epoch Times, it is part of a network of media organisations established by practitioners of the Falun Gong new religious movement. SOH serves the Chinese diaspora in US, Europe, Australia, Japan and South Korea on mediumwave and FM and broadcasts to China on an extensive number of out-of-band shortwave frequencies. Programmes are in Chinese and Cantonese, and also include relays of Radio Free Asia at times.

**Note:** this schedule of relays from Tashkent is subject to confirmation; some frequencies may have changed for A24 and will be updated in due course, there may be additional transmissions not yet showing.

Radio Dengê Gel, believed to be operating from a transmitter in Tashkent, may move to an adjacent frequency within the range of 11510-11550 kHz between 0330-1600 and 7440-7460 kHz between 1600-2200 in order to avoid the Turkish jammer which shadows it.

## Vietnam

### Voice of Vietnam

The Voice of Vietnam (also known as "Radio the Voice of Vietnam") is the Vietnamese national radio broadcaster. Directly controlled by the government of Vietnam, it is tasked with "propagating the views, policies of the Party and the laws of the state."

The following domestic services may broadcast on shortwave at present (but see comments below):

#### Voice of Vietnam - 1st National Programme

VOV-1 broadcasts news, current affairs and music programmes.

#### Voice of Vietnam - 2nd National Programme

VOV-2 broadcasts economic, social, cultural and educational programmes.

#### Voice of Vietnam - 4th National Programme for Ethnic Minorities

VOV-4 broadcasts in 11 ethnic languages and is available on MW, SW and FM in five regional versions (Northwestern, Central, Central Highlands, Ho Chi Minh City, Mekong Delta) each for 12 hours a day.



The following VOV domestic service registrations have been made with the HFCC for A24 (the service details have been added using Shiganori Aoki's data). This information is by no means an indication that all transmitters are on air at the times stated, or even on air at all. Monitoring is currently being conducted to try and establish the correct schedule for the remaining VOV domestic services on shortwave and the results will appear here shortly:
