Armenia

Hayastani Hanrayin Radio (Public Radio of Armenia) is the public broadcasting service of Armenia. All domestic broadcasts are on FM, whilst the foreign service is on mediumwave and shortwave.

International Public Radio of Armenia

International Public Radio of Armenia is the foreign service of Armenian Radio. It broadcasts in several languages to the Middle and Near East on mediumwave and shortwave. Both the mediumwave and the shortwave transmitters used by International Public Radio of Armenia are operated by Radio CJSC.

Transmitter site: Gavar, near Noratus, Gegharkunik: MW - 1000 kW; SW - 100 kW.

Azerbaijan

Azərbaycan Radiosu is the state radio service of Azerbaijan TV and Radio Broadcasting. It appears that all broadcasting from Azərbaycan Radiosu on mediumwave and shortwave has ceased.

Radio İctimai

Radio İctimai is a Baku-based FM station that is also irregularly heard on shortwave with a wideband FM transmission to interfere with broadcasts from Voice of Justice and Voice of Talyshistan (see below). It was last heard on 9677v kHz on 20 May 2017 but was back on air after around 11 months on 11 April 2018 between 0800-1400 with broadband FM modulation on 9677.5 kHz, as heard by Ivo Ivanov/SWLDX-Bulgaria.

Transmitter site: unconfirmed, presumably within Azerbaijan.

Nagorno-Karabakh

Nagorno-Karabakh is a landlocked region in the South Caucasus. It is internationally recognized as part of Azerbaijan, but most of the region is governed by the Nagorno-Karabakh Republic, a de facto independent nation established on the basis of the Nagorno-Karabakh Autonomous Oblast of the Azerbaijan Soviet Socialist Republic. Azerbaijan has not exercised political authority over the region since the advent of the Karabakh movement in 1988. (Wikipedia).

Voice of Justice

Voice of Justice started broadcasting in August 1997 to promote a better understanding between Azerbaijan and Armenia on the Nagorno-Karabakh issue. It has been several years since Voice of Justice has been positively heard on shortwave, with Voice of Talyshistan the most likely to have been using the transmitter at Stepanakert in recent years.

Voice of Talyshistan started broadcasting from Shushi, Nagorno Karabakh, in March 2013 at the initiative of the Iranian Studies Chair of the Yerevan State University and the Modus Vivendi Center. The main target audience is the 1.5 million Talysh population in Azerbaijan.

Call of Bahrain (Neda al-Bahrain)

Call of Bahrain is a programme aired over the transmitters of IRIB (Iran) to listeners in Bahrain. The purpose of the broadcast is described on www.nedaalbahrain.com as follows: "With the rise of the Islamic awakening in the world, which came to an end with the dawn of the Islamic revolution in Iran, our Islamic civilization has begun to revive the climate of return to Islam, which provides civilized solutions to the problems of economy, society, politics, education and so on. Despite the imperialist, Zionist and reactionary reaction to the wave of Islamic awakening, our various countries and societies continue to live in this tendency and tendencies at different rates. Bahrain is considered one of the countries in which the Islamic revolution was influenced by the faith of the people of this island, which quickly interacted with the Qur'anic verse of the Islamic Revolution. Today, nearly six years after the start of the popular revolution in Bahrain led by Grand Ayatollah Ali Issa Qassim, this revolution, despite its peaceful nature, is still facing a repressive escalation by the ruling regime. Therefore, in the light of recent developments in the region and particularly in Bahrain, an effective action was needed to bring the oppressed voice of the oppressed and the oppressed in this kingdom to the world to stop the blatant violations and violations committed by the ruling authority through its security services against the peaceful and genuine demands for human rights. This is a duty guaranteed by international law and believes in all divine laws. The idea of establishing the "Call of Bahrain" is a voice for truth and a voice for Muslims who suffer injustice and abuse by an authority that regards itself as a civilized state in the international system. And deprive them of the most basic rights of citizenship and plunge them into their dark prisons to practice various kinds of torture against them and their families".

Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus

Bayrak Radio and Television Corporation is the official radio and television broadcasting corporation of the self-proclaimed Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus. All stations now operate on FM. BRTK had broadcast on shortwave 6150 kHz from a 25 kW transmitter, but it is now inactive.

Georgia

Georgian Public Broadcaster is the public broadcasting service in Georgia. It operates two radio channels: Sakartvelos Radio - Pirveli Radio and Radio Ori - Kartuli Radio, both on FM. The Radio Georgia foreign service was closed in 2005.

Abkhazia

Abkhazia is a partially recognised state controlled by a separatist government on the eastern coast of the Black Sea and the south-western flank of the Caucasus. It considers itself an independent state, called the Republic of Abkhazia or Apsny. This status is recognised by Russia, Nicaragua, Venezuela, Nauru and also by the partially recognised state of South Ossetia and the unrecognised Transnistria and Nagorno-Karabakh. The Georgian government, the United Nations and the majority of the world's governments consider Abkhazia a part of Georgia's territory, though Georgia does not control it. Under Georgia's official designation it is an autonomous republic, called the Autonomous Republic of Abkhazia.

Abkhaz Radio (Apsua Radio)

Abkhaz Radio has been on the air since 1992 broadcasting from Sukhumi, capital of the self-declared Republic of Abkhazia in NW Georgia. It broadcasts programmes in Abkhaz, Georgian and Russian, and when not carrying its own programmes relays various others services from the neighbouring Russian North Caucasus region. The shortwave transmitter on 9535v kHz has not been heard recently. The confirmed schedule for Abkhaz Radio in early October 2016 on 1350 kHz is below but is frequently changing.

Iran

Islamic Republic of Iran Broadcasting is an Iranian media corporation which holds the monopoly of domestic radio and television in the Islamic Republic of Iran. It is also among the largest media organisations in Asian and Pacific region. IRIB is independent of the Iranian government.

IRIB on mediumwave

IRIB has a large number of transmitters on mediumwave offering a range of services which includes the main Radio Iran channel, provincial stations, and also the IRIB World Service for listeners in the Middle East, Caucasus, West and South Asia. IRIB provincial stations produce their own programmes during the day, usually between 0230-1630 in Persian and local languages; many also relay Radio Iran overnight between 1630-0230 and at other times. IRIB provincial stations produce a common programme called "Shabhave Iran" (Iran Nights), which is produced by each studio in turn and broadcast between 2100- 2230 on most provincial stations (note: all times will be hour earlier during summer when Iran is on daylight saving time). Please note that there a migration of Radio Iran transmitters to 558 kHz and some of these moves may not yet be reflected in list below.

With current tensions between Iran and Saudi Arabia, some IRIB Arabic transmissions are being interfered with by the Saudi's. Observations seem to indicate either a co-channel SBC station or siren-type jamming is deliberately blocking reception of IRIB Arabic. Wolfgang Bueschel, Ivo Ivanov and Tarek Zeidan have reported the following frequencies being jammed in late April/early May 2018 (all as per reports in Glenn Hauser's DX Listening Digest):

- 7410 kHz - SBC Radio Qur'an heard here
- 9650 kHz - Siren-type jamming presumably originating from Saudi Arabia heard here
- 9790 kHz - Siren-type jamming presumably originating from Saudi Arabia heard here
- 13610 kHz - Siren-type jamming presumably originating from Saudi Arabia heard here
- 13780 kHz - SBC Radio Qur'an heard here; siren-type jamming presumably originating from Saudi Arabia also heard
- 13785 kHz - Radio Saudi International in Urdu is now here from 1300; siren-type jamming presumably originating from Saudi Arabia also heard.

Al-Quds TV audio

Al-Quds TV is a Palestinian satellite channel broadcast which began broadcasting in November 2008. The station is pro-Palestinian and is licensed in London. Saudi jamming of IRIB Arabic Radio

With current tensions between Saudi Arabia and Iran, some IRIB Arabic transmissions are being interfered with by the Saudi's. Observations seem to indicate either a co-channel SBC station or siren-type jamming is deliberately blocking reception of IRIB Arabic. Radio Sawa to Scale Back Regional Broadcasts

In cost-saving move, BBG network plans to focus its OTA transmissions just on Iraq: To save \$9.5 million in 2019, the U.S. government's Arabic language broadcaster Radio Sawa plans to restrict its FM and AM transmissions to Iraq. This will mean the end of Radio Sawa's radio service, AM and FM, to the rest of the Middle East. In addition, Radio Sawa's country-centric feeds for Egypt, the Gulf, Jordan, Lebanon, Mauritania, Morocco and Sudan will be terminated, both on air and online at www.radiosawa.com. The remaining Radio Sawa Iraq feed will be streamed. Cuts to Radio Sawa are part of a bigger reduction for the Broadcasting Board of Governors in proposed federal budgets for FY 2018 and 2019. Billing itself as "America's civilian international media agency," the BBG oversees the Voice of America (VOA), Radio Free Europe/Radio Liberty (RFE/RL), Radio Free Asia (RFA), Alhurra TV and Radio Sawa (under Middle East Broadcasting Networks — MBN), and Radio and TV Martí. The BBG budget was proposed at \$661.1 million for FY 2019, down from \$685.2 million in 2018 and \$786.6 million in 2017. A BBG information page says, "Radio Sawa attracts young audiences by playing contemporary Arabic and Western music with news and information programs. It is one of the most popular radio stations in the countries where it can be heard on FM." So why is the BBG reducing Radio Sawa from a Middle Eastern regional broadcaster to an Iraq-only station? "Tough trade-offs are always necessary in austere budget climates," replied Nasserie Carew, BBG's director of global communications and public affairs. "But BBG and MBN leadership are committed to and will continue reaching people in media-restrained countries." With money being tight, Radio Sawa's non-Iraq radio broadcasts were a natural target, according to interested observers. "Eliminating the Radio Sawa network of transmitters in all countries except Iraq will save almost \$5 million," said Kim Andrew Elliott. He's a retired VOA audience research analyst and broadcaster who now produces Shortwave Radiogram a weekly program of text and images via analog shortwave radio. "Radio Sawa uses leased FM transmitters in Arab countries, plus mediumwave (AM) relays," he said, "and these are expensive." (Radio World, 29 March 2018, via Mike Terry, BDXC News Group)
